Here are **5 suggestions** to help your family to be Pilgrims of Hope!

- Live out the Gospel at Home "A family that prays together, stays together" Enthrone the Word of God or the Sacred Heart image in your home and ask the Lord to be present! Emphasize daily prayer, acts of kindness and forgiveness within the family, and praying a blessing before the meal.
- Be a witness to Joy and Hospitality Sunday is a great day to host a family meal and Rosary. Open wide the doors of your home to others who could join your family. Perhaps invite our parish priest or those in religious life to join you!
- Serve together as a family Learning to work as a family unit is a powerful way to maximise your family impact in the world. Volunteer at the parish or help another in need.
- Offer encouragement and support to other families From offering a meal to babysitting for a few hours these small offerings can make a big difference.
- Trust in Gods Providence and Radiate Hope In times of hardship, remain steadfast in faith and trust in Gods plan. Let your family's response to difficulties serve as a testament to God's faithfulness.

muscles working. The programme consists of a series of light walks in and around the city that usually take place between 2pm and 4pm each Sunday during Lent. The CrossFIT programme meets again this **Sunday 30 March at 2pm**. This week we will **walk from Manna Café down in Glenwood up to St Augustine's Hospital near the top of the ridge**. 


