Winter Living Theology

This year's Winter Living Theology lecture series which is taking place in Durban will be held at our Parish. It will consist of a three-day lecture series, as well as short morning and evening lectures, delivered by Fr Carlos Mendoza-Álvarez OP. Fr Carlos Mendoza-Álvarez OP is a Dominican friar from Mexico, who has devoted his preaching ministry to theology for over thirty years as a professor in Mexico, Switzerland, and Brazil. He has also spent the last five years teaching at Boston College in the United States.
